Murwillumbah is located in the heart of the Tweed Valley. Radio 97's Licence Area runs from the northern Gold Coast in Queensland to Byron Bay in NSW. The area includes some coastal farmland, but is mostly comprised of the fast growing coastal development that extends down from the Gold Coast.

With a population over 230,000, Radio 97's Licence Area is one of the larger regional radio markets in NSW. In comparison to the 2006 census, the population of the radio licence area of Murwillumbah has increased by 12.38% to 232,066. Murwillumbah is popular with retirees; over 52% of the population is aged over 40 years. The birthplace for 79.4% of the population was Oceania including Australian, New Zealander, Indigenous and Islander persons. Interestingly, the population of the Murwillumbah/Tweed Coast area has continued to grow when comparing the last five census counts.

Of the 43,558 people attending an educational institution, 41% were either in infants or primary school; 31% were in secondary school; 11% at TAFE and 16% at University or another tertiary institution. Of the 83,437 people who already have a tertiary qualification, 29% have a degree and 71% have a certificate, diploma or another tertiary qualification.

There is a high level of home ownership in the region. Of the total dwellings (89,834) in Murwillumbah, 34% of dwellings are owned outright and 31% are mortgaged. Private rental properties represent 29% of total dwellings.

23% of the total households (89,808) in Murwillumbah have a household income range between \$21,000 - \$41,999; 18% between \$42,000 - \$64,999; and 18% between \$65,000 - \$103,999.

All major banks, car dealers, fast-food restaurants and an extensive selection of national retail and chain stores are represented in the city.

AGRICULTURE

The area is a relatively large producer of sugar cane and tropical fruit with over 431 thousand tonnes of sugar cane were cut for crushing. The area also produced over 3 thousand tonnes of bananas, 601 thousand kilograms of avocadoes, 113 thousand kilograms of nectarines and has over 244 thousand orchard trees in the region (including nut trees).

EMPLOYMENT

The majority (51.2%) of the labour force of 108,910 is employed full time. The main industries of employment are:

- Wholesale/Retail Trade, Accommodation, Cafes & Restaurants;
- Education, Health & Community Services; and
- Manufacturing, Construction, Electricity, Gas & Water Supply.

Tourism and the growing population are the driving forces in the local economy.
