*There are 11 Commercial Radio Stations licensed to broadcast in the Sydney metropolitan area on AM/FM frequencies there is also a substantial amount of stations broadcasting on DAB+ digital radio; however other commercial radio stations can be heard in certain areas of Sydney.

In comparison to the 2006 census, the population of the Commercial Radio Licence Area in Sydney has increased by 7.22% to 3,968,043. Over 44% of the population is aged 40 years and over. The birthplace for 60.48% of the population was Oceania including Australian, New Zealander, Indigenous and Islander persons.

Of the 873,167 people attending an educational institution, 35% were in infants or primary, 29% were attending a secondary educational institution, 11% attending TAFE and 25% attending University or another tertiary institution. Of the 1,561,606 people who already have a tertiary qualification, 51% have a certificate, diploma or another tertiary qualification and 49% have a degree.

Of the total dwellings (1,365,414) in Sydney, 30% are owned outright and 35% are mortgaged. Private rental properties represent 28% of total dwellings.

18% of the total households (1,365,352) in Sydney have a household income range between \$65,000 - \$103,999, 18% between \$104,000 - \$155,999 and 18% earn an income of \$156,000+ per annum.

AGRICULTURE

According to the latest census, over one million kilograms of nectarines and over 843 thousand kilograms of peaches were produced.

EMPLOYMENT

The majority (62.59%) of the labour force of 1,993,145 is employed full time. The main industries of employment are:

- Wholesale/Retail Trade, Accommodation, Cafes & Restaurants;
- Government Administration & Defence; and
- Education, Health & Community Services.
