### LONGREACH

Famous for being the first base for Qantas Airlines, Longreach is a thriving regional centre in Central Western Queensland, about 1,200km northwest of Brisbane on the Landsborough Highway and 700km west of Rockhampton on the Tropic of Capricorn. Longreach is a regional administrative, pastoral and tourism centre. 4LG and West FM's Licence Area is the largest in Australia covering an area approximately twice the size of Victoria. The Licence Area stretches down almost to the South Australian border.

The population within the Radio Licence Area of Longreach is 15,583; a 28.28% increase from the 2006 census. Over 47% of the population is aged over 40 years. The birthplace for 89.9% of the population was Oceania including Australian, New Zealander, Indigenous and Islander persons.

Extensive educational facilities are offered in Longreach. There are pre-schools, a kindergarten, primary schools, a state high school, TAFE Annex, an Open Learning Centre, School of Distance Education, a Regional School Support Centre, a Special Education unit and the Australian Agricultural College.

Of the 2,458 people attending an educational institution, 60% were in infants or primary, 23% were attending a secondary educational institution, 9% attending university or another tertiary institution and 8% attending TAFE. Of the 4,128 people who already have a tertiary qualification, 24% have a degree and 76% have a certificate, diploma or another tertiary qualification.

Of the total dwellings (5,575) in Longreach, 37% are owned outright and 21% are mortgaged. Private rental properties represented 29% of total dwellings. 18% of the total households (5,559) in Longreach have a household income range between \$21,000-\$41,999pa, 17% between \$42,000-\$64,999pa and 17% between \$65,000-\$103,999pa.

Most major banks, car dealers and a selection of national retail, chain and independent stores are represented in the district.

Tourism is a major industry, with Longreach being home of the Australian Stockman's Hall of Fame, the Qantas Founders Outback Museum and a number of outback attractions.

#### AGRICULTURE

Outback western Queensland is tough country. The Longreach Radio Licence Area includes almost 1.3 million beef cattle. The area provides grazing land for over 1.2 million sheep and lambs.

#### **EMPLOYMENT**

Longreach has a thriving economy and business sector. The majority (72.7%) of the labour force of 8,591 is employed full time. The main industries of employment are:

- Agriculture:
- Education, Health & Community Services; and
- Wholesale/Retail Trade, Accommodation, Cafes & Restaurants.

The area around Longreach is a farming community. Almost 35% of the workforce is on the land.
